## Kimberley Sixth Form Entry Criteria for Admissions in September 2025

We want all students at Kimberley to fulfil their potential and to be aspirational and successful in their future progression upon leaving the college. This starts with choosing the right subjects to study at Post 16. Applicants are advised to talk to their current schools/subject teachers about their potential in the subjects they intend to study and should be proactive in looking at potential pathways after Sixth Form, to ensure they are studying the right subjects and are achieving the grades necessary for progression. At Kimberley, we want students to enrol on courses which they will enjoy and which most importantly they are likely to be successful studying.

Each course has its own entry criteria which students must achieve to study the subject. The entry criteria is there to ensure that learners have appropriate skills, knowledge and understanding from previous study at Key Stage 4 to ensure smooth and successful progression at Key Stage 5 and beyond. Please be aware that a small number of subjects have additional specific entry criteria. The college will allocate final places to students in subjects in August based upon achieving the entry criteria and having a high enough APS to be placed in the subject. As part of the entry criteria we require students to have 8 qualifications. We review the average GCSE points awarded from all the awarded grades at the end of Key Stage 4 with the best 8 subjects (including GCSE English and GCSE Mathematics). An average GCSE points score (APS) can be calculated by adding all the grades awarded to the learner and dividing by 8. Where a student has taken qualifications other than GCSEs, the grade awarded in this subject is converted to a GCSE grade.

In line with the majority of Post-16 providers, courses will only run if there is sufficient demand and the college reserves the right to amend the curriculum offer at any time.

### Applying for a place

Applicants must complete an application online via the Applicaa platform - <a href="http://kimberleycollege.applicaa.com/2026">http://kimberleycollege.applicaa.com/2026</a> before the deadline of **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> December 2025.** If an applicant misses the deadline their application will be considered a late application.

All students will need to upload to Applicaa their most recent school grade sheet which demonstrates the grades they are likely to achieve by the end of Year 11. We are aware some applicants will receive updated academic attainment information after 10<sup>th</sup> December (deadline day). Should you not receive a conditional offer from the college due to grades supplied before 10<sup>th</sup> December we will contact you to see if a more recent grade sheet is available for our consideration.

#### Cognitive Ability Tests (CAT)

Applicants will only be made a conditional offer once the full application process has been completed. This year we require all applicants to have completed an online Cognitive Ability Test (CAT) before our conditional offers are made. These tests will be hosted at Kimberley College, and will take place in the week of 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026. The data from the CAT will assist the college in understanding the learning needs of each applicant and may assist us in discussions about appropriate subject combinations.
