- Dress code (Cocktail/Black-Tie) - TBC

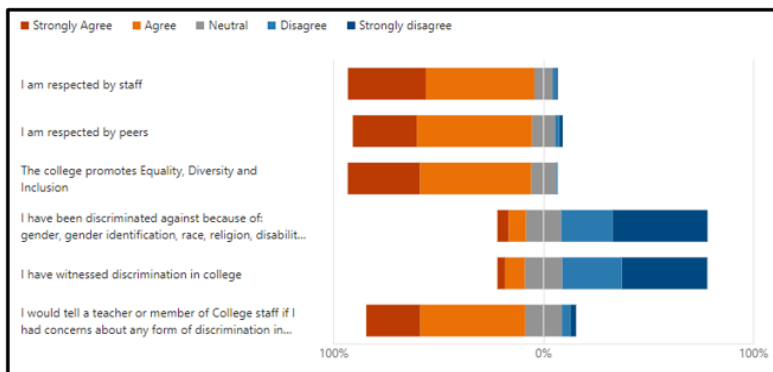
PLEASE NOTE

We will update you with some of the steps we have taken over the next few weeks in response to the student survey which was completed in December 2023

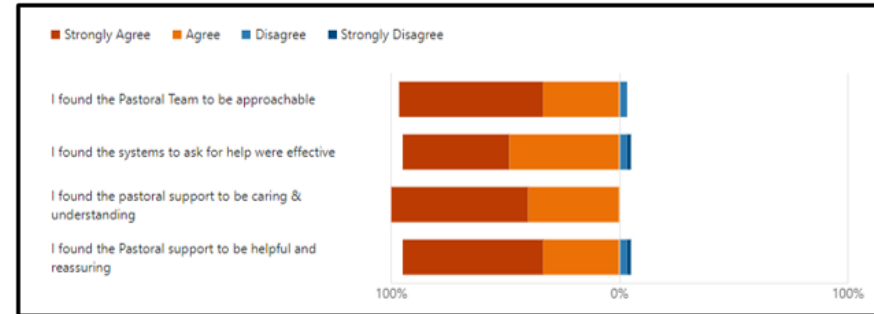
Please rate the following statements in relation to equality, diversity & inclusion within the college

Please rate the following statements based on your 1to1 support from your Pastoral Tutor or the wider pastoral Team:




96.6% of you agree that the Pastoral Team are approachable


