

All applicants must have achieved a minimum of

- A grade 4 or higher in both English (Lang. or Lit.) and mathematics GCSE.
- A minimum average GCSE point score of at <u>least</u> 4.0 across six further GCSE subjects in addition to English and maths
- Meet any specific subject entry requirements of your chosen A level courses

If an applicant achieves the minimum qualification, they have limited access to courses (only Art, Dance A-level and Graphics BTEC Diploma). To access the full range of courses, the applicant must achieve the minimum entry criteria **and** have a sufficiently high GCSE APS to secure one of the places in the subject they wish to study. If they achieve the minimum grade for a subject but their APS is not high enough to be awarded a place, they will be placed on a waiting list or offered alternative subjects.

### **Further Maths Pathway**





Students following A level Further Maths may wish to pick a fourth A-level subject. This is the only time a student can study four A-levels. To follow this pathway applicant must achieve.

- 1. Min. grade 5 in GCSE English (Lang. or Lit.) and 7 in GCSE Maths
- 2. Minimum average GCSE point score of at <u>least</u> 5.0 across six further GCSE subjects.
- 3. Meet any specific subject entry requirements of your chosen A Level courses

Normally students complete A-level Maths in Y12 then Further Maths in Y13 To follow this pathway applicants must choose Further Mathematics first when making their subject choices - this automatically allocates them to both Maths & Further Maths classes.



## **Cognitive Ability Test (CAT)**



All applicants must complete a Cognitive Ability Test (CAT) prior to enrolment. These online tests will be hosted at Kimberley College. We will contact applicants upon receipt of their application and advise on how to book your CAT. Results of the test will inform teachers of the academic strengths and weaknesses of applicants.



# Interviews and conditional offers



- Please make sure the application form is completed in detail with academic evidence as recent as possible. We do not anticipate interviewing all applicants.
- Where we receive large numbers of applications from a single school we will work with that school to share information about applicants.
- Conditional offers will be made to students based upon the criteria outlined in our admissions policy. We will send out conditional offers upon completion of all aspects of the application process up to Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2026.
- Applicants have 10 days to respond to the conditional offer, failure to do so may result in the withdrawal of a conditional offer.
