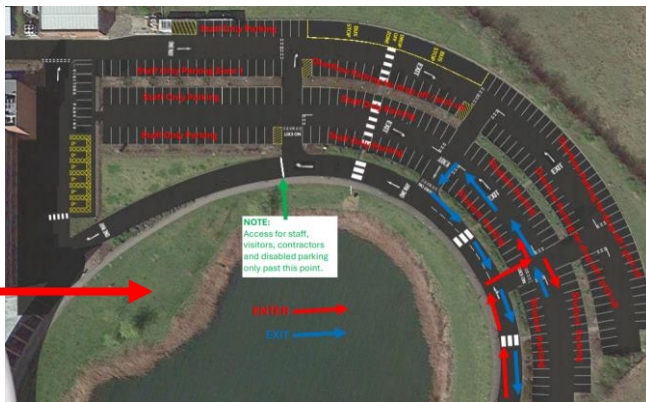
Y12 Newly Qualified Drivers

We will be checking permits in the w/c Monday 19th May.

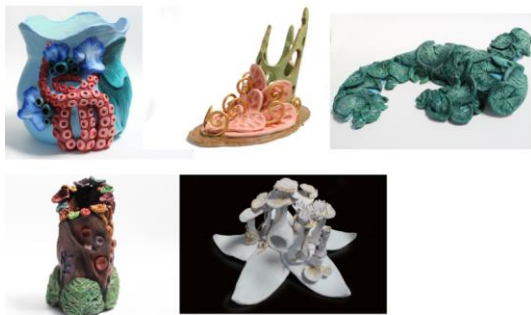


Harmony Art Exhibition
